SAINT CHRISTOPHER, NEVIS AND ANGUILLA
No. 4 of 1970.

AN ACT to amend the Export Duty Ordinance, Cap. 248.
(28th February, 1970.)

Commencement.

Be enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the house of Assembly of Saint Christopher, Nevis and Anguilla, and by the authority of the same as follows:-

1. This Act may be cited as the Export Duty Ordinance (Amendment) Act, 1970, and shall be read as one with the Export Duty Ordinance hereinafter referred to as the Principal Enactment.

Short Title.

Cap. 248.

2. The Schedule to the Principal Enactment is hereby repealed and replaced with the following:-
