Power to make
Regulations.

141. Without prejudice to any other power enabling the Minister to make Regulations the Minister may make such Regulations as he considers necessary in relation to any assigned matter and such Regulations may provide for the Comptroller to give directions, the imposition of a fine or penalty not exceeding five thousand dollars and for the forfeiture of any goods, vessel or aircraft.

Amendment of
Schedules.
Repeal of Cap. 258.

142. The Minister may by Order amend the Schedules.

143. The Trade and Revenue Act, Chapter 258 is repealed.

Savings of
Regulations.

144. The Customs Regulations and Order shall be deemed to have been made under this Act and are to be construed *mutatis mutandis* for the purpose of giving necessary effect thereto until they are varied or revoked by Regulations and Orders made under this Act.

Commencement.

145. This Act, except for section 78, shall come into operation on a day fixed by the Minister by notice published in the *Gazette*.
